

Tailgate Hinge Repair Kit

For All 1963-1991 Full Size Jeeps



Removal of Factory Pins and Bushings

- 1. Refer to factory manual for how to remove the tailgate from the vehicle (use caution with the torsion bars)
- 2. Remove the tailgate check spring
- 3. Carefully grind off the pinned end of the pin and press / tap it out
- 4. Remove old worn out bushings

Assembly of New Pins and Bushings

- 1. Position the new bushings into the holes of the body side hinge
- 2. Apply an approved lubricant on the pin and bushings (White lithium grease works well)
- 3. Place hinge halves in together and slide the new pins through the new bushings
- 4. Place the "e" clips on the new pins
- 5. Re-attach the tailgate in the same manner in which it was removed. Refer to the factory manual if necessary
